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ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 9. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez have carefully read and understand the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 79/12-171. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez have also carefully read, and understand the effects of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order.
- 10. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez are fully aware of their legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at their own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right to present evidence and to testify on their own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 11. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waive and gives up each and every right set forth above.

CULPABILITY

- 12. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez, individually, admit the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 79/12-171.
- 13. Respondent Go Go Smog agrees that his Automotive Repair Dealer Registration and Smog Check Station License are subject to discipline and he agrees to be bound by the Director's probationary terms as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.
- 14. Respondent Yanez agrees that his Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License is subject to discipline and he agrees to be bound by the Director's probationary terms as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.

RESERVATION

15. The admissions made by Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez herein are only for the purposes of this proceeding, or any other proceedings in which the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs, the Bureau of Automotive Repair, or other professional

licensing agency is involved, and shall not be admissible in any other criminal or civil proceeding.

CONTINGENCY

- 16. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Director of Consumer Affairs or his designee. Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez, individually, understand and agree that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Bureau may communicate directly with the Director and staff of the Department of Consumer Affairs regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to or participation by Respondents. By signing the stipulation, Respondent Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez, individually, understand and agree that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Director considers and acts upon it. If the Director fails to adopt this stipulation as the Decision and Order, then the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Director shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 17. The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 18. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 19. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Disciplinary Order:

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DISCIPLINARY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD261602 and Smog Check Station License Number RC261602 issued to Respondent Gustavo Gonzalez, doing business as Go Go Smog & Auto Glass ("Respondent Go Go") are revoked. The revocation of Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License Number EA152083 issued to Respondent Irvin Jesus Yanez ("Respondent Yanez") is revoked. However, the Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD261602 and Smog Check Station License Number RC261602 and Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License Number EA152083 are stayed, and each is placed on probation for three (3) years, on the following terms and conditions.

1. Actual Suspension.

- a. Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD261602 and Smog Check Station License Number RC261602 issued to Respondent Go Go are suspended for fifteen (15) consecutive days from the effective date of the decision.
- b. Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License Number EA152083 issued to Respondent Yanez is suspended for fifteen (15) consecutive days from the effective date of the decision.
- 2. **Obey All Laws.** Respondent Go Go and Respondent Yanez shall comply with all statutes, regulations and rules governing automotive inspections, estimates and repairs.
- 3. **Post Sign.** Respondent Go Go shall post a prominent sign at Go Go Smog and Respondent Yanez shall post a prominent sign at his place of employment (the signs will be provided by the Bureau) indicating the beginning and ending dates of their respective suspensions and indicating the reasons for the suspension. The signs shall be conspicuously displayed in a location open to and frequented by customers and shall remain posted during the entire period of actual suspension.
- 4. **Reporting.** Respondent Go Go and Respondent Yanez, or their authorized representative, must report in person or in writing as prescribed by the Bureau, on a schedule set by the Bureau, but no more frequently than each quarter, on the methods used and success achieved in maintaining compliance with the terms and conditions of probation.

- 5. **Report Financial Interest.** Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this action, Respondents shall each report any financial interest which any partners, officers, or owners of the Respondent Go Go facility may have in any other business required to be registered pursuant to Section 9884.6 of the Business and Professions Code.
- 6. **Random Inspections.** Respondents shall provide Bureau representatives unrestricted access to inspect all vehicles (including parts) undergoing repairs, up to and including the point of completion.
- 7. **Jurisdiction.** If an accusation or petition to revoke probation is filed against Respondent Go Go or Respondent Yanez during the term of probation, then the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs shall have continuing jurisdiction over this matter until the final decision on the accusation or petition to revoke probation, and the period of probation shall be extended until such decision.
- 8. **Violation of Probation.** Should the Director determine that Respondent Go Go or Respondent Yanez has failed to comply with the terms and conditions of probation, then the Director may, after giving notice and opportunity to be heard, revoke the Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD261602 or the Smog Check Station License Number RC 261602, or both, issued to Respondent Go Go, or the Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License Number EA631690 issued to Respondent Yanez.
- 9. **Continuing Education Courses.** During the period of probation, Respondent Yanez, at his own expense, shall attend and successfully complete a BAR Certified 68 Hour Technician Training Course in diagnosis and repair of emission systems failures and engine performance, applicable to the class of license held by Respondent Yanez. Said course shall be completed and proof of completion submitted to the Bureau within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this decision and order. If proof of completion of the course is not furnished to the Bureau within the sixty (60) day period, then Respondent Yanez's Advanced Emission Specialist License Number EA631690 shall be immediately suspended until such proof is received.
- 10. **Cost Recovery.** Respondent Go Go shall pay cost recovery to he Bureau for its investigation and enforcement costs in this matter in the amount of \$8,646.95. Payment to the

Bureau shall be paid in twenty-four (24) equal monthly installments and the full amount of cost recovery shall be received no later than twelve (12) months before probation terminates. Failure to complete payment of cost recovery within this time frame shall constitute a violation of probation which may subject Respondent Go Go's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD261602 and Smog Check Station License Number RC:261602 to outright revocation. However, the Director or his/her designee at the Bureau may elect to continue probation until such time as reimbursement of the entire cost recovery amount has been made to the Bureau.

12	STATUTORY PROVISIONS
13	5. Section 9884.7 of the Business and Professions Code ("Code") states, in pertinent
14	part:
15 16 17	(a) The director, where the automotive repair dealer cannot show there was a bona fide error, may deny, suspend, revoke, or place on probation the registration of an automotive repair dealer for any of the following acts or omissions related to the conduct of the business of the automotive repair dealer, which are done by the automotive repair dealer or any automotive technician, employee, partner, officer, or member of the automotive repair dealer.
181920	(1) Making or authorizing in any manner or by any means whatever any statement written or oral which is untrue or misleading, and which is known, or which by the exercise of reasonable care should be known, to be untrue or misleading.
21	(4) Any other conduct that constitutes fraud.
22	(b) Except as provided for in subdivision (c), if an automotive repair dealer operates more than one place of business in this state, the director pursuant to
23	subdivision (a) shall only suspend, revoke, or place on probation the registration of the specific place of business which has violated any of the provisions of this chapter. This violation, or action by the director, shall not affect in any manner the right of the
24	automotive repair dealer to operate his or her other places of business.
2526	(c) Notwithstanding subdivision (b), the director may suspend, revoke, or place on probation the registration for all places of business operated in this state by an automotive repair dealer upon a finding that the automotive repair dealer has, or is, engaged in a course of repeated and willful violations of this chapter, or regulations
27 28	adopted pursuant to it. ///

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6. Code section 118, subdivision (b) states:

The suspension, expiration, or forfeiture by operation of law of a license issued by a board in the department, or its suspension, forfeiture, or cancellation by order of the board or by order of a court of law, or its surrender without the written consent of the board, shall not, during any period in which it may be renewed, restored, reissued, or reinstated, deprive the board of its authority to institute or continue a disciplinary proceeding against the licensee upon any ground provided by law or to enter an order suspending or revoking the license or otherwise taking disciplinary action against the licensee on any such ground.

- 7. Code section 9884.13 provides, in pertinent part, that the expiration of a valid registration shall not deprive the director or chief of jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary proceeding against an automotive repair dealer or to render a decision invalidating a registration temporarily or permanently.
- 8. Code section 477 provides, in pertinent part, that "Board" includes "bureau," "commission," "committee," "department," "division," "examining committee," "program," and "agency." "License" includes certificate, registration or other means to engage in a business or profession regulated by the Code.
- 9. Section 44002 of the Health and Safety Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Director has all the powers and authority granted under the Automotive Repair Act for enforcing the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.
 - 10. Section 44072.2 of the Health and Safety Code states, in pertinent part:

The director may suspend, revoke, or take other disciplinary action against a license as provided in this article if the licensee, or any partner, officer, or director thereof, does any of the following:

- (a) Violates any section of this chapter [the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program (Health and Saf. Code, § 44000, et seq.)] and the regulations adopted pursuant to it, which related to the licensed activities.
- (c) Violates any of the regulations adopted by the director pursuant to this chapter.
- (d) Commits any act involving dishonesty, fraud, or deceit whereby another is injured.
- 11. Section 44072.6 of the Health and Safety Code provides, in pertinent part, that the expiration or suspension of a license by operation of law, or by order or decision of the Director

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of Consumer Affairs, or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of the license shall not deprive the Director of jurisdiction to proceed with disciplinary action.

12. Section 44072.8 of the Health and Safety Code states:

When a license has been revoked or suspended following a hearing under this article, any additional license issued under this chapter in the name of the licensee may be likewise revoked or suspended by the director.

COST RECOVERY

13. Code section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that a Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

UNDERCOVER OPERATION – DECEMBER 21, 2011

documented 2006 Chevrolet Silverado to Respondent Go Go's facility and requested a smog inspection. The vehicle could not pass the visual portion of a smog inspection because the vehicle's exhaust gas recirculation ("EGR") system was missing. Respondent Yanez performed the smog inspection and issued electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740274C for that vehicle. The operator paid \$50 for the smog inspection and received a copy of Invoice No. 002691 and the Vehicle Inspection Report ("VIR").

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Misleading Statements)

15. Respondent Go Go has subjected his registration to discipline under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(1), in that on or about December 21, 2011, he made statements which he knew or which by exercise of reasonable care he should have known were untrue or misleading when he issued electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740274C for the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, certifying that the vehicle was in compliance with applicable laws and regulations when, in fact, the vehicle's EGR system was missing.

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SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Fraud)

16. Respondent Go Go has subjected his registration to discipline under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(4), in that on or about December 21, 2011, he committed acts which constitute fraud by issuing electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740274C for the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, without performing a bona fide inspection of the emission control devices and systems on that vehicle, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Violation of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

- 17. Respondent Go Go has subjected his station license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (a), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he violated sections of that Code, as follows:
- a. Section 44012, subdivision (a): Respondent Go Go failed to determine that all emission control devices and systems required by law were installed and functioning correctly in accordance with test procedures.
- b. Section 44012, subdivision (f): Respondent Go Go failed to perform emission control tests on that vehicle in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.
- c. Section 44015, subdivision (b): Respondent Go Go issued electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740274C without properly testing and inspecting the vehicle to determine if it was in compliance with section 44012 of that Code.

FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Violations of Regulations Pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

18. Respondent Go Go has subjected his station license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (c), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he violated sections of the California Code of Regulations, title 16, as follows:

- a. Section 3340.35, subdivision (c): Respondent Go Go issued electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740274C even though that vehicle had not been inspected in accordance with section 3340.42 of that Code.
- b. Section 3340.42: Respondent Go Go failed to conduct the required smog tests and inspections on that vehicle in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.

FIFTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Dishonesty, Fraud or Deceit)

19. Respondent Go Go has subjected his station license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud or deceit whereby another was injured by issuing electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740247C for that vehicle without performing a bona fide inspection of the emission control devices and systems on the vehicle, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

SIXTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Violations of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

- 20. Respondent Yanez has subjected his technician license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (a), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he violated sections of that Code, as follows:
- a. Section 44012, subdivision (a): Respondent Yanez failed to determine that all emission control devices and systems required by law were installed and functioning correctly in accordance with test procedures.
- b. Section 44012, subdivision (f): Respondent Yanez failed to perform emission control tests on that vehicle in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.
- c. Section 44032: Respondent Yanez failed to perform tests of the emission control devices and systems on that vehicle in accordance with section 44012 of that Code.

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SEVENTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Violations of Regulations Pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

- 21. Respondent Yanez has subjected his technician license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (c), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he violated sections of the California Code of Regulations, title 16, as follows:
- a. Section 3340.30, subdivision (a): Respondent Yanez failed to inspect and test that vehicle in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 44012.
- b. Section 3340.41, subdivision (c): Respondent Yanez entered false information into the Emission Inspection System for electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740247C by entering "Pass" for the visual inspection for the EGR system when, in fact, the vehicle could not pass the visual inspection because the vehicle's EGR system was missing.
- c. Section 3340.42: Respondent Yanez failed to conduct the required smog tests and inspections on that vehicle in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.

EIGHTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Dishonesty, Fraud or Deceit)

22. Respondent Yanez has subjected his technician license to discipline under Health and Safety Code section 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that on or about December 21, 2011, regarding the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado, he committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud or deceit whereby another was injured by issuing electronic Certificate of Compliance No. OI740247C without performing a bona fide inspection of the emission control devices and systems on that vehicle, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

PRIOR CITATIONS

- 23. To determine the degree of penalty, if any, to be imposed upon Respondents Go Go and Yanez, Complainant alleges as follows:
- a. On July 28, 2010, the Bureau issued Citation No. C2011-0104 to Respondent Go Go against his station license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44012, subdivision (f)

(failure to perform a visual/functional check of emission control devices) and California Code of Regulations, title 16, ("Regulation"), section 3340.35, subdivision (c) (issuing a certificate of compliance to a vehicle improperly tested). Respondent Go Go issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle with a missing positive crankcase ventilation system. The Bureau assessed a civil penalty of \$1,000. Respondent Go Go complied with this citation on September 27, 2010.

- b. On November 2, 2010, the Bureau issued Citation No. C2011-0550 to Respondent Go Go against his station license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44012, subdivision (f) (failure to perform a visual/functional check of emission control devices) and Regulation, section 3340.35, subdivision (c) (issuing a certificate of compliance to a vehicle improperly tested). Respondent Go Go issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle equipped with an unapproved adjustable fuel pressure regulator. The Bureau assessed a civil penalty of \$1,500. Respondent Go Go complied with this citation on January 7, 2011.
- c. On May 13, 2011, the Bureau issued Citation No. C2011-1240 to Respondent Go Go against his station license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44012, subdivision (f) (failure to perform a visual/functional check of emission control devices). Respondent Go Go issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle with a non-functional malfunction indicator lamp. The Bureau assessed a civil penalty of \$1,500. Respondent Go Go appealed this citation on June 30, 2011. Respondent Go Go paid the citation on January 30, 2012, and withdrew the appeal on February 2, 2012.
- d. On July 28, 2010, the Bureau issued Citation No. M2011-0105 to Respondent Yanez against his technician license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44032, (qualified technicians shall perform tests of emission control systems and devices in accordance with section 44012 of that Code) and California Code of Regulations, title 16, ("Regulation") section 3340.30, subdivision (a) (qualified technicians shall inspect, test, and repair vehicles in accordance with sections 44012 and 44035 of the Health and Safety Code, and Regulation section 3340.42). Respondent Yanez issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle with a missing positive crankcase ventilation system. Respondent Yanez was required to attend an 8-hour training course. Respondent Yanez complied with this citation on August 14, 2010.

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- e. On November 2, 2010, the Bureau issued Citation No. M2011-0551 to Respondent Yanez against his technician license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44032, (qualified technicians shall perform tests of emission control systems and devices in accordance with section 44012 of that Code) and California Code of Regulations, title 16, ("Regulation") section 3340.30, subdivision (a) (qualified technicians shall inspect, test, and repair vehicles in accordance with sections 44012 and 44035 of the Health and Safety Code, and Regulation section 3340.42). Respondent Yanez issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle equipped with an unapproved adjustable fuel pressure regulator. Respondent Yanez was required to attend a 16-hour training course. Respondent Yanez complied with this citation on December 14, 2010.
- f. On May 13, 2011, the Bureau issued Citation No. M2011-1241 to Respondent Yanez against his technician license for violations of Health and Safety Code section 44032, (qualified technicians shall perform tests of emission control systems and devices in accordance with section 44012 of that Code). Respondent Yanez issued a certificate of compliance to a Bureau vehicle with a non-functional malfunction indicator lamp. Respondent Yanez was required to attend a 68-hour training course. Respondent Yanez appealed this citation on June 28, 2011; however, Respondent Yanez withdrew the appeal and completed the training on January 30, 2012.

OTHER MATTERS

- 24. Under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (c), the director may invalidate temporarily or permanently or refuse to validate, the registrations for all places of business operated in this state by Gustavo Gonzalez, upon a finding that he has, or is, engaged in a course of repeated and willful violations of the laws and regulations pertaining to an automotive repair dealer.
- 25. Under Health and Safety Code section 44072.8, if Smog Check Station License Number RC 261602, issued to Gustavo Gonzalez doing business as Go Go Smog & Auto Glass, is revoked or suspended, any additional license issued under this chapter in the name of said licensee may be likewise revoked or suspended by the director.
- 26. Under Health and Safety Code section 44072.8, if Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License Number EA 631690, issued to Irvin Jesus Yanez, is revoked or suspended,

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
