

BUREAU CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Complete this application in accordance with the instructions below and include additional pages and documents as necessary. The Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) cannot consider an application for licensure unless all requested information is provided.

Check the appropriate box for either New Instructor Certification or Renewal of Instructor Certification. If this application is for renewal, enter the Certified Instructor (CI) number previously assigned by BAR.

Please follow the instructions below to assist you in answering sections 1 - 11 on the application.

SECTION 1-11 (COMPLETE ALL SECTIONS).

1. **APPLICANTS NAME:** Provide the exact name as listed on your Smog Check Inspector (EO) and Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) licenses.
2. **HOME ADDRESS:** Provide your street address, city, state, and zip code as listed on your EI and EO licenses.
3. **ALTERNATE ADDRESS:** If you prefer to receive your mail at an address other than your home address, such as a PO Box, please complete section 3.
4. **HOME TELEPHONE NUMBER:** Provide your home area code and phone number.
5. **WORK TELEPHONE NUMBER:** Provide your work area code and phone number.
6. **EMAIL ADDRESS:** Provide your email address. The email address should be the same as that listed on the California Automotive Resources Center website at www.bar.ca.gov/calarc to ensure that you receive all email notifications from BAR.
7. **SMOG CHECK LICENSE NUMBER AND EXPIRATION DATE:** List your EI/EO license number as well as the expiration date. Please attach copies of your EO and EI licenses in addition to copies of your National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) A6, A8, and L1 certifications, and if providing diesel training, the A9 certification.
8. **INSTITUTION(S) OF EMPLOYMENT AND INSTITUTION NUMBER:** Provide the name of the BAR certified training institution(s) where you are employed and the institution number. If you teach at more than one institution, use additional pages to list all institutions. This ensures that BAR lists you as an instructor at each of the institutions listed on the application and ensures you can issue certificates of completion at any of the institutions.
9. **APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:** To qualify, a CI applicant must meet all of the following requirements:
 - Possess a current Smog check Inspector (EO) and Repair Technician (EI) license.
 - Does not have any BAR citations or any BAR administrative actions in the last 36 months.
 - Have relevant teaching experience/education in one or more of the following areas:
 - Teaching credential from the California Department of Education; or
 - Six semester college unit on the subject of vocational teaching; or
 - Letter of recommendation from a high school or community college administrator documenting a minimum of one-year teaching experience for the applicant.
10. **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** Answer all questions a - f. Attach additional information to this application as required.

Expedited application assistance is available for current or former United States military personnel and spouses or domestic partners of active duty or reserve military personnel. A waiver of renewal requirements is available for active duty or reserve military personnel. To apply for expedited application assistance or a renewal requirement(s) waiver, you must submit required documentation as specified at www.bar.ca.gov. (See Health and Safety Code section 44031.5(d) and Business and Professions Code sections 114.3 and 115.5.)

Expedited application assistance is available for applicants who were admitted to the United States as a refugee under Section 1157 of Title 8 of the United States Code, applicants who have been granted asylum by the Secretary of Homeland Security or the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Section 1158 of Title 8 of the United States Code, or applicants who have a special immigrant visa (SIV) that has been granted status under Section 1244 of Public Law 110-181, under Public Law 109-163, or under Section 602(b) of Title VI of Division F of Public Law 111-8.  - An order from a court competent jurisdiction or other documentary evidence that provides reasonable assurance that the applicant qualifies for expedited licensure.
11. **CERTIFICATION:** Read, sign, and date section 11 of the application. Your signature affirms that all statements are true and correct. Any false statement made on this application may result in denial of the application or legal action later to revoke the certification.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Per California Civil Code Section 1798.17 (Information Practice Act), the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs is responsible for maintaining the information in this application. This information may be transferred to other governmental and enforcement agencies. Individuals have the right to review the records maintained on them by the agencies, unless the records are exempt by Section 1798.40 of the Civil Code.

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION: Complete the attached application. Give all applicable information, as requested in the instructions. Send the completed application to BAR’s Hardware Certification and Schools Unit listed on the application. After your certification is initially approved and processed, you will be notified of the written exam and oral presentation dates. The average processing time is 6-8 weeks from the receipt of your application depending on scheduling dates for testing and the oral presentation.

RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATION: You must renew your license by submitting an Application for Renewal every two years. The Bureau of Automotive Repair may email you a courtesy notice approximately 60 days before expiration of your current certification. However, if you do not receive a renewal notice, you are still responsible for renewing your certification.
