Chapter 437, Statutes of 2013 (SB 459)

- Provided authority for DCA/BAR to define the allowable number of days of registration lapse and delinquency when considering applications for vehicle retirement (see Regulations)
- Provided ARB flexibility to make improvements to EFMP

Regulations: CAP Vehicle Registration

- Regulations now provide for vehicle owners to participate in both RA and VR despite lapses in vehicle registration:
 - No more than 120 days from the most recent registration expiration date; and
 - No more than 120 days during the previous two registration cycles
- > As a result, application approvals have increased by:
 - 9% for RA over the previous fiscal year; and
 - 25% for VR over the same period

Regulations: ARB Amendments to EFMP

- > Retirement-only program administered by BAR:
 - Limited to low-income motorists
 - \$1,500 retirement incentive
 - Requires completion of Smog Check inspection
- > Approved by OAL on April 9, 2015

Regulations: ARB Amendments to EFMP

- Pilot Retire and Replace program administered by San Joaquin Valley and South Coast air districts
- > Approved by OAL on April 9, 2015
