# Cal-VISTA Scope

- High Level Summary
  - Negotiate ownership of the System
  - Refresh the System to a State owned data center
  - Publish an RFP to obtain ongoing Maintenance and Operation (M&O) services

# Cal-VISTA Status

- RFP Development
  - Draft RFP complete
  - RFP submitted to DCA Business Services Office (BSO) for formal review
  - RFP submitted to DCA Legal for informal review
  - Bidders' Library development in process

# Cal-VISTA Status

- Move to OTech Data Center
  - Cal-VISTA Project Schedule
    - Project Schedule is in development
  - Project Management Plans
    - Project control documents are in development

# Cal-VISTA Status

- Move to OTech Data Center
  - Dial-up to IP is available in Test/Production
  - Project Resources
    - Multiple resources already onboard
    - Remaining resources to be onboard soon
  - Hardware/Software Procurement
    - 3 Oracle Exadata DB servers installed
    - Hardware and software procurement is in process

- RFP review and approval process
- Continue move to OTech
  - Finalize project management processes
  - Finalize project schedule
  - Complete remaining procurement
  - Onboard remaining resources
- Control and manage work

- BAR-97 Dial Up to IP Conversion
  - Continue to have quality of service issues
  - Updated regulations in DCA review
  - Communication Specification updated
  - Test Environment established
  - Production Environment established

# Cal-VISTA Timeline

- **Baseline Completion Dates**
  - Project Analysis / Planning – June/July 2016
  - RFP Development – March 2017
  - RFP Approval / Release – June 2017
  - RFP Responses Due – October 2017
  - Transition System to OTech – April 2018
  - RFP Vendor Selection – June 2018
  - Contract Transition – November 2018
