

**STIPULATION FOR REVOCATION OF  
LICENSE AND DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-  
20 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

21 PARTIES

22 1. Patrick Dorais (Complainant) is the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair,  
23 Department of Consumer Affairs, State of California (Bureau). He brought this action solely in  
24 his official capacity and is represented in this matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of  
25 the State of California, by Sterling A. Smith, Deputy Attorney General.

26 2. On or about April 22, 2010, the Bureau issued Advanced Emission Specialist  
27 Technician License No. EA 632002 to Respondent Joel Brandon Teczon (Respondent). On  
28 August 29, 2012, the license was suspended, expired on November 30, 2013, and has not been

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1 renewed. Respondent does not have an attorney to represent him, having elected to represent  
2 himself in these proceedings

3 JURISDICTION

4 3. Accusation No. 79/15-55 was filed before the Director of Consumer Affairs  
5 (Director), for the Bureau of Automotive Repair (Bureau), and is currently pending against  
6 Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served  
7 on Respondents on October 24, 2014. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting  
8 the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 79/15-55 is attached as exhibit A and incorporated  
9 herein by reference.

10 ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

11 4. Respondent has carefully read and understands the charges and allegations in  
12 Accusation No. 79/15-55. Respondent has also carefully read and understands the effects of this  
13 Stipulation for Revocation of License and Disciplinary Order.

14 5. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a  
15 hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at  
16 his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to  
17 present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel  
18 the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and  
19 court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California  
20 Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

21 6. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and  
22 every right set forth above.

23 CULPABILITY

24 7. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation  
25 79/15-55. The admissions made by Respondent herein are solely for the purpose of this  
26 proceeding or any other proceeding in which the Bureau of Automotive Repair or the Department  
27 of Consumer Affairs is involved.

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1 DISCIPLINARY ORDER

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License No. EA  
3 632002 issued to Respondent Joel Brandon Teczon is revoked outright. From and after the  
4 effective date of the decision, Respondent Joel Brandon Teczon shall have no right or privilege to  
5 engage in activities in the State of California requiring a smog technician license.

6 1. The revocation of Respondent's Advanced Specialist Technician License shall  
7 constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent.

8 2. On or before the effective date of the decision, Respondent shall cause to be delivered  
9 to the Bureau of Automotive Repair his pocket smog technician license.


10 3. Respondent fully understands and agrees that if he ever files an application for licensure  
11 as a smog technician, the registrar shall treat it as an application or petition for issuance of a new  
12 license. Respondent must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures required for  
13 issuance of a smog technician license in effect at the time the application or petition is filed.

14 4. As a condition precedent to consideration by the Bureau of Automotive Repair of  
15 Respondent's application for issuance of a new smog technician license, Respondent shall fully  
16 pay the Bureau of Automotive Repair its costs of investigation and prosecution in the amount of  
17 \$1,005.00.

18 ACCEPTANCE

19 I have carefully read the above Stipulation for Revocation of License and Disciplinary  
20 Order, understand the stipulation, and understand the effect it will have on my Advanced  
21 Emission Specialist Technician license. I enter into this Stipulation for Revocation of License  
22 and Disciplinary Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the  
23 Decision and Order of the Director of Consumer Affairs.

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

**ACCUSATION**

17 Respondent.

18 Patrick Dorais ("Complainant") alleges:

19 **PARTIES**

- 20 1. Complainant brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity as the Chief of the  
21 Bureau of Automotive Repair ("Bureau"), Department of Consumer Affairs.
- 22 2. On or about April 22, 2010, the Bureau issued Advanced Emission Specialist  
23 Technician License Number EA 632002 to Joel Brandon Teczon ("Respondent"). On August 29,  
24 2012, the license was suspended, expired on November 30, 2013, and has not been renewed.  
25 Upon renewal of the license, the license will be re-designated as EO 632002 and/or EI 632002.<sup>1</sup>

26 <sup>1</sup> Effective August 1, 2012, California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 3340.28,  
27 3340.29, and 3340.30 were amended to implement a license restructure from the Advanced  
28 Emission Specialist Technician (EA) license and Basic Area (EB) Technician license to Smog  
Check Inspector (EO) license and/or Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) license.



1 CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

2 (Failure to Comply with Citation)

3 9. Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Health and Safety Code section  
4 44050(e), in that on or about June 20, 2012, the Bureau issued Citation No. M2012-1819 to  
5 Respondent against his technician license for violating Health and Safety Code section 44032  
6 (qualified technicians shall perform tests of emission control systems and devices in accordance  
7 with section 44012 of that Code) and California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 3340.30(a)  
8 (qualified technicians shall inspect, test, and repair vehicles in accordance with sections 44012  
9 and 44035 of the Health and Safety Code, and Regulation section 3340.42)<sup>2</sup>. On or about  
10 July 23, 2012, the Bureau served Respondent with the Citation. The Bureau required that  
11 Respondent complete a 16-hour training course or appeal the Citation within thirty (30) days of  
12 receipt of the Citation. Respondent did not appeal the Citation nor has Respondent completed the  
13 required training.

14 OTHER MATTERS

15 10. Under Health and Safety Code section 44072.8, if Respondent's technician license,  
16 currently designated as EA 632002, and as re-designated upon timely renewal as EO 632002  
17 and/or EI 632002, is/are revoked or suspended, any additional license issued under this chapter in  
18 the name of said licensee may be likewise revoked or suspended by the director.

19 PRAYER

20 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,  
21 and that following the hearing, the Director of Consumer Affairs issue a decision:

- 22 1. Revoking or suspending Joel Brandon Teczon's technician license, currently  
23 designated as EA 632002, and upon renewal to be re-designated as EO 632002 and/or EI 632002;  
24 2. Revoking or suspending any additional license issued under Chapter 5 of the Health  
25 and Safety Code in the name of Joel Brandon Teczon;

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
27 <sup>2</sup> On or about April 27, 2012, Respondent issued Certificate of Compliance No. [REDACTED]  
28 to a Bureau undercover vehicle with a missing Positive Crankcase Ventilation valve.

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3. Ordering Joel Brandon Teczon to pay the Bureau of Automotive Repair the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3;

4. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
