FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about May 9, 2013, Complainant John Wallauch, in his official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Accusation No. 79/13-78 against Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., Owner; and Joseph Robert Vance, Sr. (Respondent) before the Director of Consumer Affairs. (Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)

1 2. On or about March 4, 2011, the Bureau of Automotive Repair issued Automotive
2 Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD 264291 to Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance,
3 Sr., Owner (Respondent). The Automotive Repair Dealer Registration will expire on March 31,
4 2014, unless renewed.

5 3. On or about April 8, 2011, the Bureau of Automotive Repair issued Smog Check,
6 Test Only, Station License Number TC 264291 to Respondent. The Smog Check, Test Only,
7 Station License will expire on March 31, 2014, unless renewed.

8 4. In or about 2002, the Bureau of Automotive Repair issued Advanced Emission
9 Specialist Technician License Number EA 142545 to Respondent. Pursuant to California Code
10 of regulations, title 16, section 3340.28, subdivision (e), said license was renewed pursuant to
11 Respondent's election as Smog Check Inspector (EO) License No. 142545 and Smog Check
12 Repair Technician (EI) License No. 142545, effective May 7, 2013. The Smog Check Inspector
13 (EO) License and Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) License will expire on April 30, 2015,
14 unless renewed.¹

15 5. On or about May 14, 2013, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class Mail
16 copies of the Accusation No. 79/13-78, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for
17 Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at
18 Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is
19 required to be reported and maintained with the Bureau. Respondent's addresses of record were
20 and (as to the first of the following two addresses) are: 15515 Bear Valley Road, Hesperia, CA
21 92345; and 21444 Nisqually Road, Apple Valley, CA 92308 (this particular address of record has
22 since been changed to 14806 Erie Rd., Apple Valley, CA 92307).

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26 ¹ Effective August 1, 2012, California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 3340.28,
27 3340.29, and 3340.30 were amended to implement a license restructure from the Advanced
28 Emission Specialist Technician (EA) license and Basic Area (EB) Technician license to Smog
Check Inspector (EO) license and/or Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) license.

1 6. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of
2 Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section
3 124.

4 7. On or about May 24, 2013, Respondent signed and returned a Notice of Defense,
5 requesting a hearing in this matter. A Notice of Hearing was served by mail at Respondent's
6 addresses of record and it informed him that an administrative hearing in this matter was
7 scheduled for December 12, 2013. As evidenced by the records of the United States Postal
8 Service, Respondent signed for and received by certified mail a copy of said Notice of Hearing at
9 his above and still-current 15515 Bear Valley Road, Hesperia, CA 92345 address. However,
10 Respondent failed to appear at that hearing.

11 8. Government Code section 11506 states, in pertinent part:

12 (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent
13 files a notice of defense, and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts
14 of the accusation not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense shall
15 constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion
16 may nevertheless grant a hearing.

17 9. California Government Code section 11520 states, in pertinent part:

18 (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense or to appear at the
19 hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions
20 or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to
21 respondent.

22 10. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Director after
23 having reviewed the proof of service of the Notice of Hearing dated July 26, 2013 signed by
24 Teresa Sutton, (and the USPS Track & Confirm information obtained directly from the U.S. Post
25 Office's official website) finds Respondent is in default. The Director will take action without
26 further hearing and, based on Accusation No. 79/13-78, proof of service and on the Affidavit of
27 Bureau Representative Alfred Denno finds that the allegations in Accusation No. 79/13-78 are
28 true.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

1 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent herein has subjected his
Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 264291, Smog Check, Test Only, Station

1 License Number TC 264291, Smog Check Inspector (EO) License No. 142545 and Smog Check
2 Repair Technician (EI) License No. 142545 to discipline.

3 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.

4 3. The Director of Consumer Affairs is authorized to revoke Respondent's Automotive
5 Repair Dealer Registration, based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which
6 are supported by the evidence contained in the affidavit of Bureau Representative Alfred Denno
7 in this case: **Misleading Statements** [pursuant to Code section 9884.7(a)(1)]; **Fraud** [pursuant to
8 Code section 9884.7(a)(4)]; **Violation of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program** [pursuant to
9 Health and Safety Code sections 44072.2(a), 44012(a) and (f), 44015(b) and 44059]; **Violations of**
10 **Regulations Pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program** [pursuant to Health and
11 Safety Code section 44072.2(c), and California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 3340.24(c),
12 3340.35(c) and 3340.42]; and **Dishonesty, Fraud or Deceit** [pursuant to Health and Safety Code
13 section 44072.2(d)].

14 ORDER

15 IT IS SO ORDERED that Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 264291, Smog
16 Check, Test Only, Station License Number TC 264291, and Smog Check Inspector (EO) License
17 No. 142545 and the Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) License No. 142545 heretofore issued to
18 Respondent are revoked.

19 Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a
20 written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within
21 seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The motion should be sent to the

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1 Bureau of Automotive Repair, ATTN: William D. Thomas, 10949 North Mather Blvd.,
2 Rancho Cordova, CA 95670. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a
3 hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

5 This Decision shall become effective on February 14, 2014.

Complainant alleges:

PARTIES

1. John Wallaich (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair, Department of Consumer Affairs.

1 (1) Making or authorizing in any manner or by any means whatever any statement
2 written or oral which is untrue or misleading, and which is known, or which by the exercise
3 of reasonable care should be known, to be untrue or misleading

4 (4) Any other conduct which constitutes fraud,"

5
6 (6) Failure in any material respect to comply with the provisions of this chapter or
7 regulations adopted pursuant to it.

8 7. Section 44002 of the Health and Safety Code ("HSC") provides, in pertinent part, that
9 the Director has all the powers and authority granted under the Automotive Repair Act for
10 enforcing the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

11 8. Section 44012 of the HSC provides, in pertinent part, that tests at smog check stations
12 shall be performed in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.

13 9. Section 44014, subdivision (a), of the HSC provides that the testing and repair portion
14 of the smog check program shall be conducted only by licensed smog check technicians.

15 10. Section 44015, subdivision (b), of the HSC provides that a certificate of compliance
16 shall be issued if a vehicle meets the requirements of HSC section 44012.

17 11. Section 44032 of the HSC provides, in pertinent part, that "[q]ualified technicians
18 shall perform tests of emission control devices and systems in accordance with Section 44012."

19 12. Section 44059 of the HSC provides:

20 "The willful making of any false statement or entry with regard to a material matter in any
21 oath, affidavit, certificate of compliance or noncompliance, or application form which is required
22 by this chapter or Chapter 20.3 (commencing with Section 9880) of Division 3 of the Business
23 and Professions Code, constitutes perjury and is punishable as provided in the Penal Code."

24 13. Section 44072.2 of the HSC states, in pertinent part:

25 "The director may suspend, revoke, or take other disciplinary action against a license as
26 provided in this article if the licensee, or any partner, officer, or director thereof, does any of the
27 following:

28

1 knowingly enter into the emissions inspection system any false information about the vehicle
2 being tested.”

3 19. CCR, title 16, section 3340.42, sets forth specific emissions test methods and
4 procedures which apply to all vehicles inspected in the State of California.

5 20. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 3340.28, subdivision (e), states that
6 “[u]pon renewal of an unexpired Basic Area Technician license or an Advanced Emission
7 Specialist Technician license issued prior to the effective date of this regulation, the licensee may
8 apply to renew as a Smog Check Inspector, Smog Check Repair Technician, or both.”

9 **COST RECOVERY**

10 21. Section 125.3, subdivision (a), of the BPC provides, in pertinent part, that a Board
11 “may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a
12 violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the
13 investigation and enforcement of the case.”

14 **VID DATA REVIEW-CLEAN PLUGGING**

15 22. The Bureau initiated an investigation against Respondent Vance based upon a review
16 of information from the Bureau's Vehicle Information Database (“VID”), which indicated that
17 Respondent may be engaging in fraudulent smog check activities.

18 23. On September 16, 2012, Alfred Denno (“Denno”), a representative of the Bureau,
19 conducted a detailed review of VID data for all smog inspections performed at Respondent
20 Vance's facility for the period of April 13, 2011 through July 31, 2012.

21 24. The data revealed that on or about January 18, 2012, between 1251 and 1302 hours, a
22 1996 Honda Accord, License No. 3PPY531 was inspected and issued Certificate of Compliance
23 #XD155013C by Respondent Vance. The BAR 97 inspection detail for this test shows that DTC
24 P1404 was stored in the PCM memory at the time of the certification. Service information shows
25 that code DTC P1404 is not supported by a 1996 Honda Accord.

26 25. On or about January 30, 2012, between 1716 and 1720 hours, a 2003 Chevrolet C2500
27 Silverado, License No. 7S97079 was inspected and issued Certificate of Compliance
28 #XD322287C by Respondent Vance. The BAR 97 inspection detail for this test shows that DTC

1 P1521 was stored in the PCM memory at the time of the certification. Service information shows
2 that code DTC P1521 is not supported by a 2003 Chevrolet C2500 Silverado.

3 26. On or about March 7, 2012, between 1045 and 1050 hours, a 1996 Plymouth Neon,
4 License No. 5YMN012 was inspected and issued Certificate of Compliance #XF092012C by
5 Respondent Vance. The BAR 97 inspection detail for this test shows that DTC P1506 was stored
6 in the PCM memory at the time of the certification. Service information shows that code DTC
7 P1506 is not supported by a 1996 Plymouth Neon.

8 27. On or about March 7, 2012, between 1056 and 1100 hours, a 2000 Honda Civic.
9 License No. 6HNV723 was inspected and issued Certificate of Compliance #XF092013C by
10 Respondent Vance. The BAR 97 inspection detail for this test shows that DTC P1506 was stored
11 in the PCM memory at the time of the certification. Service information shows that code DTC
12 P1506 is not supported by a 2000 Honda Civic.

13 28. On or about July 31, 2012, between 1252 and 1302 hours, a 2000 Toyota Tundra
14 License No. 6J07833 was inspected and issued Certificate of Compliance # XJ549696C by
15 Respondent Vance. The BAR 97 inspection detail for this test shows that DTC P0108 was stored
16 in the PCM memory at the time of the certification. Service information shows that code DTC
17 P0108 is not supported by a 2000 Toyota Tundra.

18 29. The Bureau concluded that Respondent Vance performed the smog inspections on the
19 five vehicles using a different vehicle during the OBD II tests, a method known as "clean
20 plugging",² resulting in the issuance of fraudulent certificates of compliance for the vehicles. The
21 following chart ("Table 1") summarizes the clean plugging activities discovered by Bureau
22 Representative Denno's analysis of the Joe's Test Only Smog, VID data for April 13, 2011
23 through July 31, 2012:

25 ² Clean-plugging is the use of the OBD II readiness monitor status and stored fault code
26 (trouble-code) status of a passing vehicle for the purpose of illegally issuing a smog certificate to
27 another vehicle that is not in compliance due to a failure to complete the minimum number of self
28 tests, known as monitors, or due to the presence of a stored fault code that indicates an emission
control system or component failure.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Misleading Statements)

30. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected his registration to discipline under BPC section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(1), in that he made statements which he knew or which by exercise of reasonable care should have known were untrue or misleading when he issued electronic certificates of compliance for the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above, certifying that those vehicles were in compliance with applicable laws and regulations when, in fact, those vehicles had not been so inspected.

SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Fraud)

31. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected his registration to discipline under BPC section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(4), in that he committed

1 acts which constitute fraud by issuing electronic certificates of compliance for the vehicles set
2 forth in Table 1 above, without performing bona fide inspections of the emission control devices
3 and systems on those vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the
4 protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

5 **THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

6 **(Material Violation of Automotive Repair Act)**

7 32. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected
8 his registration to discipline under BPC section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(6), in that he failed in a
9 "material respect to comply with the provisions of this chapter or regulations adopted pursuant to
10 it" when he issued electronic certificates of compliance for the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above,
11 without performing bona fide inspections of the emission control devices and systems on those
12 vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded by the
13 Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

14 **FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

15 **(Violation of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)**

16 33. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected
17 his station license to discipline under HSC section 44072.2, subdivision (a), in that, with respect
18 to the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above, Respondent violated the following sections of the HSC:

19 a. **Section 44012:** Respondent Vance failed to ensure that the emission control tests
20 were performed on those vehicles in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.

21 b. **Section 44015, subdivision (b):** Respondent Vance issued electronic certificates of
22 compliance without properly testing and inspecting the vehicles to determine if they were in
23 compliance with section 44012 of the HSC.

24 c. **Section 44059:** Respondent Vance willfully made false entries for the electronic
25 certificates of compliance by certifying that those vehicles had been inspected as required when,
26 in fact, they had not.

1 FIFTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

2 (Violations of Regulations Pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

3 34. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected
4 his station license to discipline under HSC section 44072.2, subdivision (c), in that, with respect
5 to the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above, Respondent violated the following sections of title 16 of
6 the CCR:

7 a. Section 3340.24, subdivision (c): Respondent Vance falsely or fraudulently issued
8 electronic certificates of compliance without performing bona fide inspections of the emission
9 control devices and systems on those vehicles as required by HSC section 44012.

10 c. Section 3340.35, subdivision (c): Respondent Vance issued electronic certificates of
11 compliance even though those vehicles had not been inspected in accordance with section
12 3340.42 of the HSC.

13 e. Section 3340.42: Respondent Vance failed to conduct the required smog tests and
14 inspections on those vehicles in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.

15 SIXTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

16 (Dishonesty, Fraud or Deceit)

17 35. Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, has subjected
18 his station license to discipline under HSC section 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that, with respect
19 to the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above, Respondent committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud
20 or deceit whereby another was injured by issuing electronic certificates of compliance for those
21 vehicles without performing bona fide inspections of the emission control devices and systems on
22 those vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded
23 by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

24 SEVENTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

25 (Violations of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)

26 36. Respondent Vance has subjected his technician license(s) to discipline under HSC
27 section 44072.2, subdivision (a), in that he violated the following sections of the HSC with
28 respect to the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above:

1 a. **Section 44012:** Respondent Vance failed to ensure that the emission control tests
2 were performed on those vehicles in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.

3 b. **Section 44032:** Respondent Vance failed to perform tests of the emission control
4 devices and systems on those vehicles in accordance with section 44012 of the HSC, in that the
5 vehicles had been clean plugged.

6 c. **Section 44059:** Respondent Vance willfully made false entries for the electronic
7 certificates of compliance by certifying that those vehicles had been inspected as required when,
8 in fact, they had not.

9 **EIGHTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

10 **(Violations of Regulations Pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program)**

11 37. Respondent Vance has subjected his technician license(s) to discipline under HSC
12 section 44072.2, subdivision (c), in that he violated the following sections of the CCR, title 16,
13 with respect to the vehicles set forth in Table 1 above:

14 a. **Section 3340.24, subdivision (c):** Respondent Vance falsely or fraudulently issued
15 electronic certificates of compliance without performing bona fide inspections of the emission
16 control devices and systems on those vehicles as required by HSC section 44012.

17 b. **Section 3340.30, subdivision (a):** Respondent Vance failed to inspect and test those
18 vehicles in accordance with HSC section 44012.

19 c. **Section 3340.41, subdivision (c):** Respondent Vance entered false information into
20 the EIS for the electronic certificates of compliance by entering vehicle emission control
21 information for vehicles other than the vehicles being certified.

22 d. **Section 3340.42:** Respondent Vance failed to conduct the required smog tests and
23 inspections on those vehicles in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.

24 **NINTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

25 **(Dishonesty, Fraud or Deceit)**

26 38. Respondent Vance has subjected his technician license(s) to discipline under HSC
27 section 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that he committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud or deceit
28 whereby another was injured by issuing electronic certificates of compliance for the vehicles set

1 forth in Table 1 above, without performing bona fide inspections of the emission control devices
2 and systems on those vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the State of California of the
3 protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

4 OTHER MATTERS

5 39. Pursuant to Bus. & Prof. Code section 9884.7, subdivision (c), the Director may
6 suspend, revoke, or place on probation the registration for all places of business operated in this
7 state by Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr., owner, upon a finding that
8 Respondent has, or is, engaged in a course of repeated and willful violations of the laws and
9 regulations pertaining to an automotive repair dealer.

10 40. Pursuant to Health & Saf. Code section 44072.8, if Smog Check, Test Only, Station
11 License Number TC 264291, issued to Respondent Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance,
12 Sr., owner, is revoked or suspended, any additional license issued under this chapter in the name
13 of said licensee may be likewise revoked or suspended by the director.

14 41. Pursuant to Health & Saf. Code sections 44072.8, if Respondent Joseph Robert
15 Vance, Sr.'s Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License currently designated as EA
16 142545 and as redesignated upon timely renewal as EO 142545 and/or EI 142545, is revoked or
17 suspended, any additional license issued under this chapter in the name of said licensee may be
18 likewise revoked or suspended by the director.

19 PRAYER

20 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
21 and that following the hearing, the Director of Consumer Affairs issue a decision:


- 22 1. Revoking or suspending Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD
23 264291, issued to Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr.;
- 24 2. Revoking or suspending Smog Check, Test Only, Station License Number TC
25 264291, issued to Joe's Test Only Smog, Joseph Robert Vance, Sr.;
- 26 3. Revoking or suspending Joseph Robert Vance, Sr.'s Advanced Emission Specialist
27 Technician License currently designated as EA 142545, and as redesignated upon timely renewal
28 as EO 142545 and/or EI 142545.

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4. Ordering Joseph Robert Vance, Sr. to pay the Bureau of Automotive Repair the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3;

5. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
