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25	FINDINGS OF FACT	
26	1. On or about September 15, 2025, Complainant Patrick Dorais, in his official capacity	
27	as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed	
28	Accusation No. 79/25-2844 against David Dalon, dba D Smog Center, and Jason Matthew Ugerio	

before the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs. (Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)
This Default Decision and Order applies to Jason Matthew Ungerio (Respondent), only.

- 2. In 2003, The Bureau issued Advanced Emission Specialist Technician License
 Number EA 147150 to Respondent. Respondent's advanced emission specialist technician
 license was cancelled on March 12, 2013. Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 16,
 section 3340.28, subdivision (e), the license was renewed, pursuant to Respondent Ugerio's
 election, as Smog Check Inspector License Number EO 147150 and Smog Check Repair
 Technician License No. 147150, effective March 12, 2013. The Smog Check Inspector License
 will expire on June 30, 2027 unless renewed. Smog Check Repair Technician License expired on
 June 30, 2019, and has not been renewed.
- 3. On or about September 19, 2025, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class Mail copies of the Accusation No. 79/25-2844, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Bureau. Respondent's address of record was and is:

- 4. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505(c) and/or Business and Professions Code section 124.
 - 5. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:
 - (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent files a notice of defense . . . and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation . . . not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense . . . shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.

¹ Effective August 1, 2012, California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 3340.28, 3340.29, and 3340.30 were amended to implement a restructuring of Bureau licenses from Advanced Emission Specialist Technician (EA) License and Basic Area (EB) Technician License to Smog Check Inspector (EO) License and and/or Smog Check Repair Technician (EI) License.

- 6. The Bureau takes official notice of its records and the fact that Respondent failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon him of the Accusation, and therefore waived his right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. 79/25-2844.
 - 7. California Government Code section 11520(a) states, in pertinent part:
 - (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense . . . or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to respondent
- 8. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Director after having reviewed the proof of service dated September 19, 2025, signed by Jose Katigbak, finds Respondent is in default. The Director will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 79/25-2844, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

- Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Jason Matthew Ugerio has subjected his Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 147150 and Smog Check Repair Technician License No. EI 147150 to discipline.
 - 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.
- 3. The Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs is authorized to revoke Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this case:
 - a. Respondent has subjected his Smog Check Inspector and Smog Check Repair

 Technician Licenses to discipline under Health and Safety Code sections 44072.10

 and/or 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that he committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud
 or deceit, whereby another was injured by issuing electronic certificates of
 compliance for vehicles without performing bona fide inspections of the emission
 control devices and systems on the vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the State

of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program
Respondent participated in clean-plugging.

- b. Respondent has subjected his Smog Check Inspector and Smog Check Repair Technician Licenses to discipline under Health and Safety Code sections 44072.10 and/or 44072.2, subdivisions (a) and (c), in that he violated sections of that Code and applicable regulations, through Clean Plugging, as follows:
 - i. **Section 44012**: Respondent failed to ensure that smog inspections were performed on vehicles in accordance with procedures prescribed by the department.
 - ii. Section 3340.24, subdivision (c): Respondent falsely or fraudulently issued electronic certificates of compliance to certain vehicles without performing bona fide inspections of the emission control devices and systems on those vehicles.
 - iii. Section 3340.30, subdivision (a): Respondent failed to inspect the vehicles in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 44012 and California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 3340.42.
 - iv. Section 3340.41, subdivision (c): Respondent entered false information about vehicles being tested into OIS.
 - v. Section 3340.42: Respondent failed to conduct the required smog tests and inspections on certain vehicles in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.
 - vi. Section 3340.45 Respondent violated the procedures contained in the Smog Check Manual by entering vehicle identification information for a vehicle that was not being tested.
 - vii. **Section 44059:** Respondent willfully made false statements in issuing the Smog Certificates of compliance and on the Vehicle Inspection Reports.

ORDER

IT IS SO ORDERED that Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 147150 and Smog Check Repair Technician License No. EI 147150, issued to Respondent Jason Matthew Ugerio, are revoked.

2	written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within		
3	seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The motion should be sent to the

5	Mather Boulevard Rancho Cordova, CA 95670. The agency in its discretion may vacate the		
6	Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.
