SECOND CAUSE TO REVOKE PROBATION

At all times after the effective date of Respondent's probation, Condition 8 stated:

Maintain Valid License. Respondent shall, at all times while on probation, maintain a current and active registration and/or license(s) with BAR, including any period during which suspension or probation is tolled. If Respondent's registration or license is expired at the time the decision becomes effective, the registration or license must be renewed by Respondent within 30 days of that date. If Respondent's registration or license expires during a term of probation, by operation of law or otherwise, then upon renewal Respondent's registration or license shall be subject to any and all terms and conditions of probation not previously satisfied. Failure to maintain a current and active registration and/or license during the period of probation shall also constitute a violation of probation.

Respondent's probation is subject to revocation because he failed to comply with Probation Condition 8, referenced above, in that Respondent failed to maintain a current and active license with the Bureau when he failed to renew his license that expired on March 31,

THIRD CAUSE TO REVOKE PROBATION

At all times after the effective date of Respondent's probation, Condition 13 stated:

Training Course. During the period of probation, Respondent shall attend and successfully complete a sixty-eight (68) hour BAR-specified and approved training course in inspection, diagnosis and/or repair of emission systems failures and engine performance, applicable to smog check technicians. Respondent shall provide to the Bureau proof of enrollment in the course within 6 months of the effective date of the decision, and proof of successful course completion within 360 days of the effective date of the decision. Failure to provide proof of enrollment and/or successful course completion to the Bureau within the timeframes specified shall constitute a violation of probation, and Respondent shall be prohibited from issuing any certificate of compliance or noncompliance until such proof is

Respondent's probation is subject to revocation because he failed to comply with Probation Condition 13, referenced above, in that Respondent failed to submit, within 360 days of the effective date of the decision, due on or before March 25, 2022, proof of successful completion of required training courses, a sixty-eight (68) hour BAR specified and approved
