STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND DISCIPLINARY ORDER (79/18-1079)

1	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-			
2	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:			
3	PARTIES			
4	1. Patrick Dorais (Complainant) is the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair			
5	(Bureau or BAR). He brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in this			
6	matter by Xavier Becerra, Attorney General of the State of California, by Brian Lee, Deputy			
7	Attorney General.			
8	2. Respondents Issa S. Maymoun dba Smog All, Issa Sallba Maymoun and Jalal Issal			
9	Haddad are representing themselves in this proceeding and has chosen not to exercise their right			
10	to be represented by counsel.			
11	3. On or about January 1, 2002, the Bureau issued Automotive Repair Dealer			
12	Registration No. ARD 225167 to Issa S. Maymoun dba Smog All ("Respondent Smog All"). The			
13	Automotive Repair Dealer Registration was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the			
14	charges brought in Accusation No. 79/18-1079, and will expire on December 31, 2019, unless			
15	renewed.			
16	4. On or about December 23, 2002, the Bureau issued Smog Check, Test Only, Stationl			
17	License No. TC 225167 to Respondent Smog All. The Smog Check, Test Only, Station License			
18	was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 79/18-			
19	1079, and will expire on December 31, 2019, unless renewed.			
20	5.1 In 2002, the Bureau issued Advanced Emission Specialist License No. EA 1455311			
21	to Issa Sallba Maymoun ("Respondent Maymoun"). Said license was renewed pursuant to			
22	Respondent Maymoun's election as a Smog Check Inspector (E $\bullet$ ) License No. 145531 and Smog			
23	Check Repair Technician (EI) License No. 145531, effective November 9, 2012.1 <sup>1</sup> The Smog			
24	Check Inspector license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in			
25	Accusation No. 79/18-1079, and will expire on December 31, 2020, unless renewed. The Smog			
26	Check Repair Technician License expired on December 31, 2014, and has not been renewed.

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	STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND DISCIPLINARY ORDER (79/18-1079)			

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6.e On or about January 10, 2015, the Bureau issued Smog Check Inspector License No.e EO 637761 to Jalal Issa Haddad ("Respondent Haddad"). Said license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 79/18-1079, and will expire on August 31, 2020, unless renewed.

#### **JURISDICTION**

6 7. Accusation No. 79/18-1079 was filed before the Director, and is currently pendinge
7 against Respondents. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly
8 served on Respondents on August 20, 2018. Respondents timely filed their Notice of Defense
9 contesting the Accusation.

8.e A copy of Accusation No. 79/18-1079 is attached as exhibit A and incorporatede
herein by reference.

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#### ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

9.e Respondents have carefully read, and understand the charges and allegations ine
Accusation No. 79/18-1079. Respondents have also carefully read, and understand the effects of
this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order.

10.e Respondents are fully aware of their legal rights in this matter, including the right to ae 17 hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at 18 their own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right 19 to present evidence and to testify on their own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to 20 compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration 21 and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California 22 Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

11.e Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each ande
every right set forth above.

#### **CULPABILITY**

12.e Respondents understand and agree that the charges and allegations in Accusation No.e
79/18-1079, if proven at a hearing, constitute cause for imposing discipline upon Respondent
Smog All's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration and Smog Check, Test Only, Station License;

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Respondent Maymoun's Smog Check Inspector License and Smog Check Repair Technician License; and Respondent Haddad's Smog Check Inspector License.

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13.e For the purpose of resolving the Accusation without the expense and uncertainty of e
further proceedings, Respondents agree that, at a hearing, Complainant could establish a factual
basis for the charges in the Accusation, and that Respondents hereby gives up their right to
contest those charges.

7 14.e Respondents agree that their respective registration and licenses are subject toe
8 discipline and agree to be bound by the Director's probationary terms as set forth in the
9 Disciplinary Order below.

#### **CONTINGENCY**

15.e This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Director of Consumer Affairs ore 11 the Director's designee. Respondents understand and agree that counsel for Complainant and the 12 staff of the Bureau of Automotive Repair may communicate directly with the Director and staff of 13 the Department of Consumer Affairs regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to 14 or participation by Respondents or their counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondents 15 understand and agree that they may not withdraw their agreement or seek to rescind the 16 stipulation prior to the time the Director considers and acts upon it. If the Director fails to adopt 17 this stipulation as the Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall 18 be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action 19 between the parties, and the Director shall not be disqualified from further action by having 20 considered this matter. 21

16.e The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimilee
copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including PDF and facsimile
signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

17.e This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be ane
integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement.
It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions,
negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary

Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

18.e In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree thate
the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
Disciplinary Order:

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#### **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD
225167 and Smog Check, Test Only, Station License No. TC 225167, issued to Issa S. Maymoun
dba Smog All; Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 145531 and Smog Check Repair
Technician License No. EI 145531 issued to Issa Sallba Maymoun; and Smog Check Inspector
License No. EO 637761 issued to Jalal Issa Haddad, are revoked. However, the revocations are
stayed and Respondents are placed on probation for five (5) years on the following terms and
conditions, which include seven (7) days actual suspension.

Obey All Laws. During the period of probation, Respondents shall comply with alle
 federal and state statutes, regulations and rules governing all BAR registrations and licenses held
 by Respondents.

2.e Posting of Sign. During the period of suspension, Respondents shall prominentlye
post a sign or signs, provided by BAR, indicating the beginning and ending dates of the
suspension and indicating the reason for the suspension. The sign or signs shall be conspicuously
displayed in a location or locations open to and frequented by customers. The location(s) of the
sign(s) shall be approved by BAR and shall remain posted during the entire period of actual
suspension.

3.e Quarterly Reporting. During the period of probation, Respondents shall reporte
either by personal appearance or in writing as determined by BAR on a schedule set by BAR, but
no more frequently than once each calendar quarter, on the methods used and success achieved in
maintaining compliance with the terms and conditions of probation.

4.e Report Financial Interests. Respondents shall, within 30 days of the effective datee
of the decision and within 30 days from the date of any request by BAR during the period of

probation, report any financial interest which any Respondent or any partners, officers, or owners of any Respondent facility may have in any other business required to be registered pursuant to Section 9884.6 of the Business and Professions Code.

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Access to Examine Vehicles and Records. Respondents shall provide BAR
 representatives unrestricted access to examine all vehicles (including parts) undergoing service,
 inspection, or repairs, up to and including the point of completion. Respondents shall also provide
 BAR representatives unrestricted access to all records pursuant to BAR laws and regulations.

6.e Tolling of Probation. If, during probation, a Respondent leaves the jurisdiction of e 8 California to reside or do business elsewhere or otherwise ceases to do business in the jurisdiction 9 of California, the Respondent shall notify BAR in writing within 10 days of the dates of departure 10 and return, and of the dates of cessation and resumption of business in California. All provisions 11 of probation other than cost reimbursement requirements, restitution requirements, training 12 requirements, and that Respondent obey all laws, shall be held in abeyance during any period of 13 time of 30 days or more in which Respondent is not residing or engaging in business within the 14 jurisdiction of California. All provisions of probation shall recommence on the effective date of 15 resumption of business in California. Any period of time of 30 days or more in which Respondent 16 is not residing or engaging in business within the jurisdiction of California shall not apply to the 17 reduction of this probationary period or to any period of actual suspension not previously 18 completed. Tolling is not available if business or work relevant to the probationary license or 19 registration is conducted or performed during the tolling period. 20

7. Violation of Probation. If a Respondent violates or fails to comply with the termse
and conditions of probation in any respect, the Director, after giving notice and opportunity to be
heard may set aside the stay order and carry out the disciplinary order provided in the decision.
Once Respondent is served notice of BAR's intent to set aside the stay, the Director shall maintain
jurisdiction, and the period of probation shall be extended until final resolution of the matter.

8.e Maintain Valid License. Respondents shall, at all times while on probation,e
maintain a current and active registration and/or license(s) with BAR, including any period during
which suspension or probation is tolled. If a Respondent's registration or license is expired at the

time the decision becomes effective, the registration or license must be renewed by the Respondent within 30 days of that date. If a Respondent's registration or license expires during a term of probation, by operation of law or otherwise, then upon renewal the Respondent's registration or license shall be subject to any and all terms and conditions of probation not previously satisfied. Failure to maintain a current and active registration and/or license during the period of probation shall also constitute a violation of probation.

9.e Cost Recovery. Respondent Maymoun shall pay the Bureau of Automotive Repaire 7 \$2,863.73 for the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of case No. 79/18-1079. 8 Respondent Haddad shall pay the Bureau of Automotive Repair \$954.58 for the reasonable costs 9 of the investigation and enforcement of case No. 79/18-1079. Respondents shall make such 10 payments as follows: Respondent Maymoun shall make his payment by making thirty-five (35) 11 monthly installments of \$79.54 with a final payment (36<sup>th</sup> monthly installment) of \$79.83 due no 12 later than twenty-four (24) months prior to the termination of probation and Respondent Haddad 13 shall make his payment by making thirty-five (35) monthly installments of \$26.52 with a final 14 payment (36<sup>th</sup> monthly installment) of \$26.38 due no later than twenty-four (24) months prior to 15 the termination of probation. Respondents shall make payment by check or money order payable 16 to the Bureau of Automotive Repair and shall indicate on the check or money order that it is for 17 cost recovery payment for case No. 79/18-1079. Any order for payment of cost recovery shall 18 remain in effect whether or not probation is tolled. Probation shall not terminate until full cost 19 recovery payment has been made. BAR reserves the right to pursue any other lawful measures in 20 collecting on the costs ordered and past due, in addition to taking action based upon the violation 21 of probation. 22

10.e Completion of Probation. Upon successful completion of probation, Respondents'e
affected registration and/or license will be fully restored or issued without restriction, if
Respondents meet all current requirements for registration or licensure and has paid all
outstanding fees, monetary penalties, or cost recovery owed to BAR.

11.e License Surrender. Following the effective date of a decision that orders a stay of e
invalidation or revocation, if a Respondent ceases business operations or is otherwise unable to

satisfy the terms and conditions of probation, the Respondent may request that the stay be vacated. Such request shall be made in writing to BAR. The Director and the BAR. Chief reserve the right to evaluate the Respondent's request and to exercise discretion whether to grant the request or take any other action deemed appropriate or reasonable under the circumstances. Upon formal granting of the request, the Director will vacate the stay order and carry out the disciplinary order provided in the decision. Respondent may not petition the Director for reinstatement of the surrendered registration and/or license, or apply for a new registration or license under the jurisdiction of BAR at any time before the date of the originally scheduled completion of probation. If Respondent applies to BAR for a registration or license at any time after that date, Respondent must meet all current requirements for registration or licensure and pay all outstanding fees or cost recovery owed to BAR and left outstanding at the time of surrender.

12.—Actual Suspension. Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 225167 and Smog Check, Test Only, Station License No. TC 225167, issued to Issa S. Maymoun dba Smog All; Smog Check Inspector License No. BO 145531 and Smog Check Repair Technician License No. BI 145531 issued to Issa Sallba Maymoun; and Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 637761 issued to Ialal Issa Haddad, are suspended for seven (7) consecutive days beginning on the effective date of the Decision and Order.

#### ACCEPTANCE

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## Complainant alleges:

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#### **PARTIES**

Patrick Dorais (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity asn 1.n the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair ("Bureau"), Department of Consumer Affairs.

In 2002, the Bureau issued Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARDn 2.n 225167 to Issa S. Maymoun dba Smog All ("Respondent Smog All"). The Automotive Repair Dealer Registration was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought hereinn 71 and will expire on December 31, 2018, unless renewed.

3.n On or about December 23, 2002, the Bureau issued Smog Check, Test Only, Stationn 9 License Number TC 225167 to Respondent Smog All. The Smog Check, Test Only, Station 10 License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will 11 expire on December 31, 2018, unless renewed. 12

On or about June 6, 2013, the Bureau issued STAR Certification to Respondent Smog 13 4.n All. The STAR Station Certification was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the 14 charges brought herein and will remain active unless the ARD registration and/or the Smog 15 Check Station license is revoked, cancelled, or the licenses become delinquent or certification is 16 invalidated. 17

In 2002, the Bureau issued Advanced Emission Specialist License No. EA 145531 to 5. 18 Issa Sallba Maymoun<sup>1</sup> ("Respondent Maymoun"). Said license was renewed pursuant to 19 Respondent Maymoun's election as a Smog Check Inspector (EO) License No. 145531 and Smog 20Check Repair Technician (EI) License No. 145531, effective November 9, 2012.<sup>2</sup> The Smog 21 Check Inspector license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought 22 herein, and will expire on December 31, 2018, unless renewed. The Smog Check Repair 23 Technician License expired on December 31, 2014, and has not been renewed. 24

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<sup>1</sup> Respondent Maymoun was issued ARD 227311 in 2003 and Smog Check Station License No. TC 227311 on or about March 12, 2004, for his other smog station, Smog All II, located at 1104 E. Palmdale Blvd., Palmdale CA 93550. Both registration and license will expire on April 30, 2019, unless renewed.

6.e On or about January 10, 2015, the Bureau issued Smog Check Inspector License No.e EO 637761 to Jalal Issa Haddad<sup>3</sup> ("Respondent Haddad"). Said license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein, and will expire on August 31, 2018, unless renewed.

#### **JURISDICTION**

7.e This Accusation is brought before the Director of the Department of Consumere
Affairs (Director) for the Bureau, under the authority of the following laws.

8 8.e Business and Professions Code ("Bus. & Prof. Code") section 9884.13 provides, ine
9 pertinent part, that the expiration of a valid registration shall not deprive the Director of
10 jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary proceeding against an automotive repair dealer or to
11 render aglecision temporarily or permanently invalidating (suspending or revoking) a registration.

12 e 9. Health and Safety Code ("Health & Saf. Code") section 44002 provides, in pertinent
13 part, that the Director has all the powers and authority granted under the Automotive Repair Act
14 for enforcing the Motor Vehicle Inspection Program.

15 10. Health & Saf. Code section 44072.6 provides, in pertinent part, that the expiration or
suspension of a license by operation of law, or by order or decision of the Director of Consumer
Affairs, or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of the license shall not deprive the Director
of jurisdiction to proceed with disciplinary action.

#### STATUTORY PROVISIONS

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11.e Bus. & Prof. Code section 9884.7 states, in pertinent partie

(a) The director, where the automotive repair dealer cannot show there was a bona fide error, may refuse to validate, or may invalidate temporarily or permanently, the registration of an automotive repair dealer for any of the following acts or omissions related to the conduct of the business of the automotive repair dealer, which are done by the automotive repair dealer or any automotive technician, employee, partner, officer, or member of the automotive repair dealer.

#### COST RECOVERY

23. Bus. & Prof. Code section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that a Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

24.i On March 9, 2015, the Bureau implemented a statewide regulatory change requiringi 11 the use of an On-Board Diagnostic Inspection System (OIS) in testing of 2000 model year and 12 newer gas powered vehicles 14,000 Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVW) and under, and 1998 13 and newer diesel powered vehicles 14,000 GVW and under. The OIS Bureau Test Data lists 14 differences in Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN) for vehicles that have received smog 15 16 inspections, in addition to communication protocol (the language used to communicate) and Parameter ID (PID) differences with vehicles that have been certified correctly that are the same 17 make and model vehicles. 18

25.i A Bureau representative initiated an investigation and reviewed OIS test data fori 19 Respondent Smog All. The investigation revealed that the data related to certain vehicles 20 certified by Respondent Smog All contained a pattern of unmistakable discrepancies between the 21 information transmitted during the inspections and documented information known about the 22 subject vehicles. Specifically, a comparison of the data received from the certified vehicles to 23 data from vehicles of the same year, make, and model and/or prior transmitted inspections for the 24 same certified vehicle determined that the data from at least four (4) of the certified vehicles 25 contained the following unmistakable discrepancies: (1) incorrect vehicle communication 26 protocols and/or (2) incorrect PID counts. Also, discrepancies were found with respect to the 27111 28

transmitted eVINS (digitally stored VIN number in the vehicle's Power Control Module ande 1e identified by the OIS). These documented discrepancies confirm that the vehicles receiving smog certificates from Respondent Smog All were fraudulently tested during the smog inspection using the "clean plugging" method.<sup>4</sup>

26.e Moreover, the OIS test data showed that Smog Check Technicians Respondente Haddad (EO 637761) and Respondent Maymoun (EO 145531) performed three and one of the four (4) fraudulent inspections, respectively. Respondent Maymoun performed fraudulent inspections on July 31, 2017, December 6, 2017, and January 9, 2018. Respondent Haddad performed a fraudulent inspection on May 23, 2017.

27.e The following chart illustrates the documented clean plugging activities of e Respondents Smog All, Maymoun, and Haddad between May 23, 2017 and January 9, 2018;
