**DEFAULT DECISION AND ORDER AS  
TO JAFAR NASER ALSALEH ONLY**

[Gov. Code, §11520]

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On or about June 25, 2025, Complainant Patrick Dorais, in his official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair (Bureau), Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Accusation No. 79/25-2733 against Mohammed Almghazachi, dba Best Smog Station 2

1 (Respondent Best Smog Station), and Jafar Naser Alsaleh before the Bureau. (Accusation  
2 attached as Exhibit A.)

3 2. On or about July 18, 2016, the Bureau issued Smog Check Inspector License Number  
4 EO 639476 to Jafar Naser Alsaleh (Respondent Alsaleh or Respondent). The Smog Check  
5 Inspector License expired on July 31, 2024, and has not been renewed.

6 3. On or about November 7, 2018, the Bureau issued Smog Check Repair Technician  
7 License Number EI 639476 to Respondent Alsaleh. The Smog Check Repair Technician License  
8 expired on July 31, 2022, and has not been renewed.

9 4. On or about July 8, 2025, Respondent Alsaleh was served by Certified and First-Class  
10 Mail copies of the Accusation No. 79/25-2733, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense,  
11 Request for Discovery and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and  
12 11507.7) at Respondent Alsaleh's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions  
13 Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Bureau. Respondent's  
14 address of record was and is: 24905 Pine Creek Loop, Corona, CA 92883.

15 5. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of  
16 Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business and Professions Code section  
17 124.

18 6. Government Code section 11506, subdivision (c) states, in pertinent part:

19 The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent  
20 files a notice of defense . . . and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all  
21 parts of the accusation . . . not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense  
22 . . . shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its  
23 discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.

24 7. The Bureau takes official notice of its records and the fact that Respondent Alsaleh  
25 failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon him of the Accusation, and  
26 therefore waived his right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. 79/25-2733.

27 8. California Government Code section 11520, subdivision (a) states, in pertinent part:

28 If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense . . . or to appear at the  
hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions  
or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to  
respondent . . . .



1 (3) Section 3340.42: Respondent Alsaleh failed to conduct the required smog tests  
2 and inspections on those vehicles in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.

3 c. Respondent Alsaleh's smog check inspector license and smog check repair technician  
4 Licenses are subject to discipline pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 44072.2,  
5 subdivision (d), in conjunction with Health and Safety Code section 44072.10 subdivision (c), in  
6 that Respondent Alsaleh committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud or deceit whereby another  
7 was injured by issuing electronic certificates of compliance for those vehicles without performing  
8 bona fide inspections of the emission control devices and systems on the vehicles, thereby  
9 depriving the People of the State of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle  
10 Inspection Program.


11 **ORDER**

12 IT IS SO ORDERED that Smog Check Inspector License Number EO 639476 and Smog  
13 Check Repair Technician License Number EI 639476, issued to Respondent Jafar Nasar Alsaleh,  
14 are revoked.

15 Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent Alsaleh may  
16 serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on  
17 within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The motion should be sent to  
18 the Bureau of Automotive Repair, ATTN: Patrick Lutfi, 10949 North Mather Boulevard, Rancho  
19 Cordova, CA 95670. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on  
20 a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

21 This Decision shall become effective on November 25, 2025.
