FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about January 26, 2026, Complainant Patrick Dorais, in his official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Accusation No. 79/25-6010 against Tuat Xuan Pham (Respondent) dba Sky Fc before the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs. (The Accusation is attached as Exhibit A.)

1 1. On or about January 27, 2025, the Bureau issued Automotive Repair Dealer
2 Registration Number ARD 311340 to Respondent. The Automotive Repair Dealer Registration
3 was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on
4 January 31, 2027, unless renewed.

5 2. On or about April 3, 2025, the Bureau issued Smog Check Station License Number
6 TC 311340 to Respondent. The Smog Check Station License was in full force and effect at all
7 times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on January 31, 2027, unless renewed.
8 The Smog Check Station License was STAR certified on July 18, 2025.

9 3. On or about December 20, 2023, the Bureau issued Smog Check Inspector License
10 Number EO 644755 to Respondent. The Smog Check Inspector License was in full force and
11 effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on February 28, 2026,
12 unless renewed.

13 2. On or about January 27, 2026, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class
14 Mail copies of the Accusation No. 79/25-6010, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense,
15 Request for Discovery and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and
16 11507.7) at Respondent's addresses of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code
17 section 136, are required to be reported and maintained with the Bureau. Respondent's addresses
18 of record were and are:

24 3. On or about January 27, 2026, Respondent was also served by Certified and First
25 Class Mail copies of the Accusation No. 79/25-6010, Statement to Respondent, Notice of
26 Defense, Request for Discovery and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5,
27 11507.6, and 11507.7) at the physical address of Respondent's Smog Check Station which was

3 4. On or about January 27, 2026, Respondent's attorney, William Ferreira, was served
4 by Certified and First Class Mail copies of the Accusation No. 79/25-6010, Statement to
5 Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery and Discovery Statutes (Government
6 Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at his address which was and is:

9 5. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of
10 Government Code section 11505(c) and/or Business and Professions Code section 124.

11 6. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:

12 (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent
13 files a notice of defense . . . and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all
14 parts of the accusation . . . not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense
15 . . . shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its
16 discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.

17 7. The Bureau takes official notice of its records and the fact that Respondent failed to
18 file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon him of the Accusation, and therefore
19 waived his right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. 79/25-6010.

20 8. California Government Code section 11520(a) states, in pertinent part:

21 (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense . . . or to appear at
22 the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express
23 admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without
24 any notice to respondent

25 9. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Director after
26 having reviewed the proof of service dated January 27, 2026, signed by Jose Katigbak, finds
27 Respondent is in default. The Director will take action without further hearing and, based on the
28 relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter,
finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 79/25-6010, are separately and severally,
found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

1
2 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Tuat Xuan Pham dba Sky Fc has
3 subjected his Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 311340, Smog Check Station
4 License No. TC 311340, and Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 644755 to discipline.

5 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.

6 3. The Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs is authorized to revoke
7 Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration, Smog Check Station License and Smog
8 Check Inspector License, based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are
9 supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this
10 case:

- 11 a. Respondent has subjected his Automotive Repair Dealer Registration to discipline
12 under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(1), in that Respondent made statements
13 which he knew or which by exercise of reasonable care should have known were
14 untrue or misleading.
- 15 b. Respondent has subjected his Automotive Repair Dealer Registration to discipline
16 under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(4), in that he committed acts which
17 constitute fraud.
- 18 c. Respondent has subjected his Automotive Repair Dealer Registration to discipline
19 under Code section 9884.7, subdivision (a)(6), in that he violated California Code of
20 Regulations, title 16, section 3373, by creating and issuing false or misleading
21 certificates of compliance and vehicle inspection reports.
- 22 d. Respondent has subjected his Smog Check Station License and Smog Check
23 Inspector License to discipline under Health and Safety Code sections 44072.10
24 and/or 44072.2, subdivision (d), in that he committed acts involving dishonesty, fraud
25 or deceit, whereby another was injured by issuing electronic certificates of
26 compliance to vehicles without performing bona fide inspections of the emission
27 control devices and systems on those vehicles, thereby depriving the People of the
28

1 State of California of the protection afforded by the Motor Vehicle Inspection
2 Program. Respondent participated in clean-plugging.

3 e. Respondent has subjected his Smog Check Station License and Smog Check
4 Inspector License to discipline under Health and Safety Code sections 44072.10
5 and/or 44072.2, subdivisions (a) and (c), in that he violated sections of that Code and
6 applicable regulations, as follows:

- 7 i. **Section 44012:** Respondent failed to ensure that smog inspections were
8 performed on vehicles in accordance with procedures prescribed by the
9 department.
- 10 ii. **Section 3340.15, subdivision (a):** Respondent inspected vehicles outside of
11 the Bureau approved work area.
- 12 iii. **Section 3340.24, subdivision (c):** Respondent falsely or fraudulently issued
13 electronic certificates of compliance to certain vehicles without performing
14 bona fide inspections of the emission control devices and systems on those
15 vehicles.
- 16 iv. **Section 3340.30, subdivision (a):** Respondent failed to inspect the vehicles in
17 accordance with Health and Safety Code section 44012 and California Code
18 of Regulations, title 16, section 3340.42.
- 19 v. **Section 3340.41, subdivision (c):** Respondent entered false information about
20 vehicles being tested into OIS.
- 21 vi. **Section 3340.41, subdivision (h):** Respondent had electronic devices or
22 software capable of simulating the OBD data stream from a vehicle or
23 manipulating OBD VIN, calibration identification, calibration verification
24 number, MIL status, readiness, or diagnostic trouble codes collected from a
25 vehicle during a Smog Check Inspection in the approved testing area of the
26 station.
- 27 vii. **Section 3340.42:** Respondent failed to conduct the required smog tests and
28 inspections on certain vehicles in accordance with the Bureau's specifications.


