

LICENSES AND ORDER**

21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
22 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

23 **PARTIES**

24 1. Patrick Dorais (Complainant) is the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair
25 (Bureau), Department of Consumer Affairs. He brought this action solely in his official capacity
26 and is represented in this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by
27 Stephanie Alamo-Latif, Deputy Attorney General.

3 14. This Stipulated Revocation of License and Order is intended by the parties to be an
4 integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement.
5 It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions,
6 negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Revocation of License and
7 Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a
8 writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

9 15. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
10 the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
11 Order:

12 **ORDER**

13 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Automotive Repair Dealer No. ARD 300470, and Smog
14 Check, Test-and-Repair, Station License No. RC 300470 issued to Respondent Nayebkhil
15 Enterprises, dba Auto World of Sacramento, Omer Hamid Nayebkhil,
16 President/Secretary/Treasurer are hereby revoked and accepted by the Director.

17 1. The revocation of Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration and Smog
18 Check, Test-and-Repair, Station License and the acceptance of the revoked licenses by the
19 Director shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation
20 constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's license history with
21 the Bureau.

22 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as an Automotive Repair Dealer and
23 Smog Check, Test-and-Repair, Station in California as of the effective date of the Director's
24 Decision and Order.

25 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Bureau its pocket licenses and, if issued,
26 its wall certificates on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.

27 4. If Respondent ever applies for licensure or petitions for reinstatement with the Bureau
28 in the State of California, the Bureau shall treat it as a new application for licensure. Respondent

1 must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in effect at the time the
2 application or petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No.
3 77/25-7419 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Director
4 determines whether to grant or deny the application or petition.

5 5. Respondent shall pay the Bureau its costs of investigation and enforcement in the
6 amount of \$10,565.25 prior to application for a new registration or license issued by the Bureau,
7 or petition for reinstatement of a revoked license or registration.

8 6. If Respondent should ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or
9 petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other licensing agency under the Department of
10 Consumer Affairs in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in
11 Accusation, No. 77/25-7419 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent for
12 the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict
13 licensure.


14 7. Respondent shall not apply for licensure by the Bureau or petition for reinstatement to
15 the Bureau for one (1) year from the effective date of the Bureau's Decision and Order.

16 **ACCEPTANCE**
