19	In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of this matter, consistent with the public	
20	interest and the responsibilities of the Director of Consumer Affairs and the Bureau of	
21	Automotive Repair, the parties hereby agree to the following Stipulated Settlement and	
22	Disciplinary Order which will be submitted to the Director for approval and adoption as the final	
23	disposition of the STAR Certification Invalidation Appeal.	
24	<u>PARTIES</u>	
25	1. Patrick Dorais ("Complainant") is the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair. He	
26	brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in this matter by Kamala D.	
27	Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Michael Brown, Deputy Attorney General.	
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STIPULATED SETTLEMENT (2014-0028 and 2014-0029)

- 2. Respondent Golden State Auto Spa, Inc., Alberto Marquez dba Smog It, LLC, ("Respondent Smog It") is represented in this proceeding by attorney Michael B. Levin, Esq., whose address is: 3727 Camino del Rio South, Suite 200, San Diego, CA 92108.
- 3. On or about June 23, 2010, the Bureau of Automotive Repair ("Bureau") issued Smog Check Test Only Station License No. TC 262195 to Respondent Smog It. The Smog Check Test Only Station License will expire on May 31, 2016, unless renewed. On or about January 1, 2013, the Smog Check Test Only Station License was certified as a STAR station.

JURISDICTION

- 4. STAR Certification Invalidation No. 2014-0028 and 2014-0029 were filed before the Director of Consumer Affairs ("Director"), for the Bureau, and is currently pending against Respondent Smog It. The STAR Certification Invalidation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent Smog It on June 17, 2014. Respondent Smog It timely contested the STAR Certification Invalidation.
- 5. A copy of STAR Certification Invalidation No. 2014-0028 is attached as exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
- 6. A copy of STAR Certification Invalidation No. 2014-0029 is attached as exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 7. Respondent Smog It has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the charges and allegations in STAR Certification Invalidation Appeal Nos. 2014-0028 and 2014-0029. Respondent Smog It has also carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order.
- 8. Respondent Smog It is fully aware of its legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the STAR Certification Invalidation; the right to be represented by counsel at its own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right to present evidence and to testify on its own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents;

the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

9. Respondent Smog It voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

CULPABILITY

- 10. Respondent Smog It admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in STAR Certification Invalidation Nos. 2014-0028 and 2014-0029.
- 11. Respondent Smog It agrees that its STAR Certification of Smog Check Test Only Station License No. TC 262195 is subject to discipline and it agrees to be bound by the Director of Consumer Affairs imposition of discipline as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.

RESERVATION

12. The admissions made by Respondent Smog It herein are only for the purposes of this proceeding, or any other proceedings in which the Bureau of Automotive Repair, or other professional licensing agency is involved. The admissions made by Respondent Smog It shall not be admissible in any other criminal or civil proceeding.

CONTINGENCY

13. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Director of Consumer Affairs or the Director's designee. Respondent Smog It understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Bureau of Automotive Repair may communicate directly with the Director and staff of the Department of Consumer Affairs regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to or participation by Respondent Smog It. By signing the stipulation, Respondent Smog It understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Director considers and acts upon it. If the Director fails to adopt this stipulation as the Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Director shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.

- 14. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 15. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 16. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that STAR Certification of Smog Check Test Only Station License No. 262195 issued to Respondent Smog It is invalidated under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. **Invalidation.** Respondent Smog It's STAR certification shall be temporarily invalidated for a period of thirty (30) consecutive days beginning on the effective date of the Decision and Order. During the period of invalidation, Respondent Smog It shall cease advertising as a STAR station and shall cover or remove all STAR signage. During the period of invalidation, Respondent Smog It shall not perform any repairs under the Consumer Assistance Program.
- 2. Automatic Reinstatement. Upon successful completion of the 30 day invalidation, Respondent Smog It's STAR Certification shall be fully restored without reapplication for STAR certification.
- 3. Violation of Decision and Order. If Respondent Smog It violates any term and condition of this Decision and Order, then the violation shall constitute a cause to discipline Respondent Smog It's Smog Check Test Only Station License, Automotive Repair Dealer

Registration and any other Bureau issued license and or registration. 1 2 ACCEPTANCE I have carefully read the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order.
