22 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
23 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

24 **PARTIES**

25 1. Patrick Dorais (Complainant) is the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair
26 (Bureau). He brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in this matter by
27 Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Justin R. Surber, Deputy Attorney
28 General.

1 Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a
2 writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

3 14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
4 the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
5 Order:

6 **ORDER**

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 268471
8 and Smog Check Test Only Station License No. TC 268471 issued to Respondent David Dalon
9 dba D Smog Center are revoked.

10 1. The revocation of Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration and Smog
11 Check Test Only Station License shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent.
12 This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's
13 license history with the Bureau.

14 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as an Automotive Repair Dealer and
15 Smog Station in California as of the effective date of the Director's Decision and Order.

16 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Bureau his pocket license and, if one
17 was issued, his wall certificates on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.


18 4. If he ever applies for licensure or petitions for reinstatement in the State of California,
19 the Bureau shall treat it as a new application for licensure. Respondent must comply with all the
20 laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in effect at the time the application or petition is
21 filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 79/25-2844 shall be
22 deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Director determines whether to
23 grant or deny the application or petition.

24 5. Respondent shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the
25 amount of \$17,541.27 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

26 **ACCEPTANCE**


27 I have carefully read the Stipulated Revocation of Licenses and Order. I understand the
