Cal-VIS ACCOMPLISHMENTS MAY - OCTOBER 2022

- BAR-OIS software updates:
 - 21.3.1 enhanced BAR's ability to support future releases
 - 22.1 notification of low certificate inventory, biometric enrollment support
 - 22.2 Windows 11 support
- DAD 2.0 integration with BAR-OIS software requirements designed and provided to DAD vendors
- Various infrastructure maintenance, modernization, patching, security mitigation, and Oracle database updates

Cal-VIS FORECAST OCTOBER 2022 – MARCH 2023

- BAR-OIS software updates:
 - 22.3 updates security and removes dependency on browser version
 - 22.4 allows use of biometric scanner
- 23.1 Safety Systems Inspection Increment 1 of 3

BIOMETRIC DATES AND OUTREACH (1 OF 2)

- 8/15/2022 Smog Check Equipment Security and Fraud Prevention regulations approved
- 8/22/2022 Announcement of regulation approval and effective date of 10/1/2022
- 8/26/2022 Approved regulations posted to BAR's Regulatory Actions page
- 9/1/2022 Notice of biometric enrollment starting 10/1/2022
- 9/19/2022 Biometric information posted to BAR's website
 - Enrollment appointment scheduler, steps to use biometric, reseller contact information, and frequently asked questions

BIOMETRIC DATES AND OUTREACH (2 OF 2)

- 9/21/2022 reminder to view Q&As, get enrollment appointment, 30-day notice will be sent before use mandated
- 10/3/2022 Enrollment appointments starting at BAR field offices; 3,049 enrollments already scheduled
- 10/17/2022 Reminder to enroll and get equipment. A notice will be sent 30 days before the mandatory use date, yet to be determined
- January 2023


 BAR-OIS software updated to version 22.4 allowing optional biometric use
- February 2023* 30-day notice of mandatory use
- March 2023* mandatory use of biometric with BAR-OIS

BIOMETRIC ENROLLMENT APPOINTMENTS

- Use scheduler on BAR's website to make an appointment at chosen BAR field office or other BAR designated location
- BAR field offices allow walk-in enrollment from 8am to 12pm
- In areas where a BAR field office is closed, alternate BAR designated locations will perform enrollments and may have different walk-in enrollment hours

BIOMETRIC ENROLLMENT PREPARATION

- Be sure to bring the following items with you to your appointment:
 - Your biometric enrollment appointment confirmation
 - A valid, government-issued, photo identification (other than an inspector badge), such as a driver license, passport, or military identification
 - A proof of identification document showing your legal name and signature such as a social security card or credit card
 - Your BAR-issued inspector badge (if received prior to enrollment) and inspector license number
 - Notice and Consent documents are available on BAR's website, Regulatory Actions page for preview
 - Notice on Collection of Personal Biometric Information and Its Use
 - Biometric Data Collection Consent Statement

BIOMETRIC ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY

- At the enrollment appointment, BAR staff will:
 - Verify your identity
 - Review Notice and Consent and require your acceptance
 - Take your photo
 - Scan your left- and right-hand palm to establish your biometric palm data profile
 - This stored profile will be used to verify inspector identity when performing BAR-OIS inspections

BIOMETRIC EQUIPMENT

Equipment summary:

- Kits available for sale. Buy now. They will be delivered over the next six months depending on manufacturing
- Several BAR authorized resellers listed on BAR's website. They have the correct "BAR BAK" kit with sensor "FAT13FPS01" matching 2021 Smog Check Manual and have a two-year warranty
- Cost varies by reseller; estimated \$400-\$500
- One kit required per BAR-OIS
 - BAR-97 biometric not required at this time
- Can be self installed or reseller may offer installation service

BAR-OIS COMPUTER SECURITY

- The BAR On-board Diagnostics (OBD) Inspection System (BAR-OIS) utilizes a Windows-based computer that is maintained either by individual Smog Check stations, or by the vendor that leases the equipment to the station
- An important part of maintaining any computer is ensuring the operating system (OS) is supported and up to date
- When an OS is no longer supported or configured not to receive security updates, the provider of the OS is no longer able to provide software updates to address security vulnerabilities
- This puts any business utilizing computers with unsupported OS at risk of a security breach that could result in malware, stolen or lost data, and loss of revenue caused by downtime

UNSUPPORTED AND NON-UPDATED COMPUTERS AT RISK

- Many BAR-OIS computers are running on an unsupported OS or are configured not to receive security updates
- Not only are these systems at risk, but some will soon be incompatible with Smog Check software updates and thus unable to perform Smog Check inspections
- BAR will continue to provide weekly notifications via ET Blast to stations that are at risk of a lockout
- Additionally, BAR will continue to work with equipment vendors and attempt to contact at risk stations via telephone

WINDOWS 7, 8.0, AND 8.1 COMPUTERS

- If operating a leased BAR-OIS with Windows 7 or 8, please contact the vendor to schedule a system update
- If you are maintaining your own BAR-OIS computer, please arrange to have your system updated
- At this time, there is no risk of incompatibility with Smog Check software to Windows 8.1 systems that have been configured to receive security updates

DAD 2.0

- The Data Acquisition Device (DAD) used to retrieve On Board Diagnostic (OBD) data during BAR-OIS inspections will be replaced with the next generation DAD 2.0
- Ability to collect new Unified Diagnostic Services OBD data from 2024 and newer model year vehicles
- Ability to collect additional data to improve BAR fraud detection capabilities
- Will require use of a Microsoft supported windows operating system; i.e., Windows 11 or 10
- Regulations, software, hardware are in development
- BAR certification testing could begin 2024
- BAR certified DADs could be required in 2025

SAFETY INSPECTION STATUS

- BAR-OIS architecture, database, billing, transaction fee, certificate purchasing, and certificate transmission to DMV will be leveraged when building BAR-SIS
- Software requirement gathering in progress
- First software release 23.1 in first quarter 2023
- Regulations under review with DCA Legal
