Cal-VIS Overview

- The California Vehicle Inspection System (Cal-VIS) is the information technology solution that supports all aspects of BAR's Smog Check and Vehicle Safety Systems Inspection (VSSI) Programs
- Cal-VIS includes:
 - Data centers
 - Hardware
 - Software
 - Network connectivity

Cal-VIS Maintenance and Operations

- Cal-VIS requires continuous monitoring, patching, and functional updates to achieve availability targets and meet evolving business needs
- Maintenance and operations requires rigorous planning, system documentation, and testing to ensure accuracy and performance

2024 Q4 Cal-VIS Accomplishments

- 24.4 Cal-VIS Software Release
 - Requires station owners and managers assign Smog Check and Safety Systems inspector roles matching inspector license(s)
 - Inspectors subsequently assigned to that station by BAR
 - Updated the California BAR-OIS User Interface Guide (e.g., online help) to match current software functionality
 - Improved Cal-VIS registration and download website usability

2025 Q1 Cal-VIS Accomplishments

- 25.0 and 25.1 Cal-VIS Software Releases
 - Added DAD 2.0 support which will be available when DAD 2.0 is certified for station use
 - Added Windows 10 “out-of-support” warning message
 - Cal-VIS computers must use a supported Windows operating system
 - Windows 10 will no longer be supported on October 14, 2025
 - Approved use of new biometric device model number
 - Plug and play, no software changes needed

2025 Q2 Cal-VIS Accomplishments

- 25.2 Cal-VIS Software Release
 - Prompts an inspector if another inspection type is found in-progress for the same vehicle
 - Completed security audit
 - Updated system monitoring and alerting tools
 - Completed move from Oracle X6 to new Oracle X9

2025 Q3 Cal-VIS Plans

- 25.3 Cal-VIS Software Release
 - User interface portion of vehicle exhaust noise inspection software
 - Begin DAD 2.0 certification testing
 - Supporting DMV Digital eXperience Platform Project
 - STAR migration to Cal-VIS
 - Dell server upgrades
 - Site failover automation

2025 Q4 Plans

- 25.4 Cal-VIS Software Release
 - Exhaust noise inspection data collection
 - Electronic certificates of compliance available electronically
 - Inspection results added to BAR's inspection history page
