**Notice of Availability of Second Modified Text of Proposed Regulations
Concerning**

Storage Fees Charged by Automotive Repair Dealers

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bureau of Automotive Repair (“Bureau”) has proposed modifications made to proposed regulations at 16 CCR sections 3303, 3351, 3351.8.1, 3351.8.2, and 3351.8.3, related to Storage Fees Charged by Automotive Repair Dealers. These regulations were originally noticed on November 14, 2025, with a modified text noticed (for a 15-day comment period) on March 27, 2026.

Please note, comments should be restricted to the most recent modifications made to the proposed regulations. The Bureau is not required to respond to comments on other aspects of the proposed regulations received in response to this notice.

Any comments previously submitted remain in the rulemaking file and will be responded to by the Bureau’s staff as part of the Final Statement of Reasons. All written comments received by August 28, 2026, that pertain to these modifications will be reviewed and responded to by the Bureau’s staff as part of the compilation of the rulemaking file.

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, the Bureau is providing notice that documents and other information which the agency has relied upon in adopting the proposed regulations have been added to the rulemaking file and are available for public inspection and comment.
